SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The intent of the UGFOA Scholarship Program is to assist member organizations that are unable to provide funding for attendance at the UGFOA Spring Conference. Preference will be given to first time attendees and organizations and individuals that have been unable to attend UGFOA sponsored training due to budgetary constraints.

Eligibility

1. Organization must be a member of the UGFOA.
2. Recipient must be planning to continue a career in government service at the local, county, state or federal level.
3. Application must be complete, signed and postmarked by application deadline.
4. Combined organization awards did not exceed \$600 during the prior three (3) year period.

Awards

1. Awards will be determined based upon the number of applications received and funding available.
2. Individual maximum awards will be \$300.
3. All awards are paid in the form of a reimbursement to the employer organizations up to the amount of the grant. Receipts or similar documentation must be submitted to UGFOA by the scholarship recipient.
